What is provided for us at each campsite/cabin?

Although each living unit (tents or cabins) is unique, each unit contains the following equipment: cast iron for cooking over the fire (dutch ovens and frying pans: one large and one small of each), one rake, metal bucket and broom, two shovels, fire extinguisher, three dish pans, one trash can, clearly posted directions to the nearest hospital, and clearly posted emergency weather procedures. Some cabins come equipped with everything in one building, including kitchens. Others have basic cots or mattresses for sleeping only (you cook over the campfire). Most of our tent units have flush toilets, but some have latrines so read the description for each unit closely! Be sure to bring basic cleaning supplies with you each visit (to wash dishes & wipe down appliances and counters and clean the bathrooms). Each unit has a posted Kaper chart for use when preparing for check out at the end of your visit.

When do we submit our troop camping application?

Registration opens on April 1 each year for Troop Camping for the entire Girl Scout year (October thru September). We now have online registration for Troop Camping. Check the live up to date availability before you register. Make sure to list the adult(s) who have completed the Troop Outdoor Certificate and First Aider/CPR trainings. Include all adults attending so that we may verify they are registered Girl Scouts and have a completed background check on file.

When are the units available?

Always double check the online availability to see when units are available. Council staff host events on site and many weekends are reserved for these programs. Cabin units are open year-round. The Farm House at Camp Misty Mountain and the Platform tent camping at all camps begin the last weekend of March and end the weekend before Thanksgiving.

How accessible are the units for people who use a wheelchair or have limited mobility?

Accessibility is different at each camp and unit. Each campsite and many of the program areas are listed so that you can determine if the unit will meet the needs of everyone in your troop/group. Every effort is made to accommodate needs if we have prior knowledge. We cannot guarantee that every area of the camps is barrier free or wheelchair accessible.

Troop Camping Confirmation and Arrival Information

You will receive an auto reply confirmation with details after you successfully complete your online registration. This will include a form that must be completed and returned listing the names of all the girls and adults camping. It is due at least two weeks prior to your camping date. All payments are due 1 month prior to your camping date. You will receive a reminder notice via e-mail. One to two weeks before your troop camping weekend, the camp program coordinator will send you an electronic welcome packet requesting your arrival time and confirming your participant numbers. The camp site team stewards the girls' camps and eagerly awaits your arrival.

Dodd House Village - Overnight fee (1 or 2 nights) \$80.00 per cabin

Four cabins rented separately with 4 bunk beds with mattresses each cabin sleeps 8 people. Each cabin has heat and air conditioning, and access to a table and 8 folding chairs upon request. Cabins share a central Lodge with meeting space with full bathrooms. Bathrooms include toilets, showers, toilet paper, hand soap and paper towels. Kitchen rented separately. Includes a fire ring and a box of supplies that contain a coffee pot, electric skillet, crock pot and griddle to assist you in food prep. We will also provide you a cooler outside your cabin for storing your cold food items.

You can rent the entire unit by selecting each cabin and the kitchen upon registration.

No crafts containing glue, glitter, paint, wax or tie-dye.

Access to the fire ring is limited due to hilly steep terrain at the back of the building. Parking available for vehicles with valid parking permit. Please contact the Camp Staff in advance to ensure access. Entry into the bathroom is flat. There is one accessible toilet stall with raised stool and grab bars. The shower stall is roll-in with grab bars, a shower seat, and a flexible shower head with hose.</p>

<p>Dodd House Kitchen Weekend fee: \$50 Located in Lodge/meeting space area and includes refrigerator, stove, pots, pans, dishes, utensils, garbage liners, coffee maker and toaster – bring your own cleaning supplies. Kitchen is locked and only the troop renting it will have access.</p>

Gypsy Hill Village - Cabin Overnight Fee (1 or 2 nights) \$90 per cabin

Four cabins rented separately each has 4 bunk beds with mattresses and sleeps 8 people. Each cabin has heat and air conditioning. All cabins share enclosed unit shelter with heat and air conditioning. Shelter includes tables and chairs, space for programming and food prep with access to a refrigerator and kitchen sink for washing dishes. Shower and bathroom facilities attached. Camp will provide toilet paper, paper towels and hand soap. You must provide your own, heavy-duty garbage bags and cleaning supplies. You will have shared access to an open sided unit shelter with a fire ring. Each cabin will have a box of supplies that contain a coffee pot, electric skillet, crock pot and griddle to assist you in food prep. We will also provide you a cooler outside your cabin for storing your cold food items.

You can rent the entire unit by selecting each cabin upon registration.

The general terrain is level and flat. Additional assistance may be required by persons using a wheelchair for mobility to reach the unit shelter that has a two inch step up; the fire ring is open and easy to access. Cabin 3 has a low ramp allowing easy wheelchair entry. Parking available for vehicles with valid parking permit. Please contact the Camp Staff in advance to ensure access. Entry into the bathroom is flat. There is one accessible toilet stall with raised stool and grab bars. The shower stalls do not have grab bars, flexible shower head with hose, or shower seat and all have a raised lip entry that does not permit roll-in.</p>

<p>Turtle Ridge Cabin (next to Gypsy Hill)</p> <p>Overnight Maximum 10 people Overnight Fee (1 or 2 nights) \$100 No crafts containing glue, glitter, paint, wax or dye. Firewood is provided.</p>	<p>Sleeps 10 in a cabin with heat and air conditioning. Shower and bathroom facilities attached. Camp will provide toilet paper, paper towels and hand soap. You must provide your own heavy-duty garbage bags and cleaning supplies. You will have shared access to an open sided unit shelter with a fire ring. Cabin will have a box of supplies that contain a coffee pot, electric skillet, crock pot and griddle to assist you in food prep. We will also provide you a cooler outside your cabin for storing your cold food items. Table and chairs will be provided for the unit.</p>	<p>This unit is not accessible to a person using a wheelchair or with limited mobility due stair case to access the building. Terrain around the cabin is sloped and difficult to traverse if not fully mobile. The fire ring is open and easy to access. Parking available for vehicles with valid parking permit. Please contact the Camp Staff in advance to ensure access.</p>
<p>Whippoorwill Hill – Cabin Only</p> <p>Overnight Maximum 12 people Overnight Fee (1 or 2 nights) \$170 No crafts containing glue, glitter, pant, wax or dye. Firewood is provided. Kitchen is locked and only the troop renting it will have access.</p>	<p>Sleeps 12 with six bunk beds and mattresses. Bathroom with showers and toilets will be shared with all Platform Tent campers. Exclusive use of partial kitchen includes a refrigerator, stove and sink. No other items are provided. Camp will provide toilet paper, paper towels and hand soap. Please bring your own heavy-duty garbage bags and cleaning supplies.</p>	<p>The general terrain is rugged, hilly, and steep. Entry into the front of the building is by ramp and from the rear is by steps only. Access to the fire ring is level and open. Tent locations are on a hill, the tent closest to the building has ramp access. A cot can be removed to allow additional room for movement in the tent. This unit is close to the parking lot. The most direct route to the building is by a steep gravel road. Entry into the bathroom is flat. There is an accessible toilet stall, raised stool and grab bars. The shower stall is roll-in with grab bars, a shower seat, and flexible shower head with hose.</p>
<p>Whippoorwill Hill – Platform Tents Only</p> <p>Overnight Maximum 16 people Overnight fee: (1 or 2 nights) \$125 Firewood is provided No access to cabin or kitchen. The restroom/shower house in this unit does not support mixed female and male group overnights.</p>	<p>Four Platform Tent with 4 cots and mattresses. Open-sided unit shelter with fire ring, picnic tables and shared bathroom with showers and toilets with the cabin unit. A box of supplies that contain a coffee pot, electric skillet, crock pot and griddle to assist you in food prep will be provided. We will also provide a cooler for storing your cold food items. Camp will provide toilet paper, paper towels and hand soap. You must provide your own heavy-duty garbage bags and cleaning supplies.</p>	<p>General terrain is rugged, hilly & steep. Entry into front of building for bathroom use is by ramp. Access to fire ring is level and open. Tent locations are on a hill, the tent closest to the building has ramp access. A cot can be removed to allow additional room for movement in the tent. This unit is close to the parking lot. The most direct route to the building is by a steep gravel road. Entry into bathroom is flat. There is one accessible toilet stall with raised stool & grab bars. Shower stall is roll-in with grab bars and a shower seat; flexible shower head with hose.</p>

Camp will provide toilet paper, paper towels and hand soap. You must provide your own, heavy-duty garbage bags and cleaning supplies.</p> <p>Vehicle access to this unit is not possible. Please contact the camp staff in advance regarding parking.</p>	<p>Accessibility to this unit for a person using a wheelchair or with limited mobility would require assistance. Entrance into the unit is by steep rugged trail. The general terrain is mostly hilly and steep. The unit shelter has a small step up and fire ring is easily accessible with flat access. There is not a tent in this unit with ramp access. Entry into the bathroom is approximately one step onto a concrete porch. There is one accessible toilet stall with raised stool and grab bars. The shower stalls have grab bars and flexible shower head with hose with a raised lip entry that does not permit roll-in.</p>
<p>Tall Timbers – Platform Tent Overnight: Maximum 28 people Overnight Fee (1 or 2 nights) \$125 Firewood is provided.</p>	<p>Seven platform tents, four cots and mattresses in each. Open-sided unit shelter with shower and bathroom facilities, picnic tables, charcoal grill, unit equipment, electricity, water and fire ring. Camp will provide toilet paper, paper towels and hand soap. You must provide your own, heavy-duty garbage bags and cleaning supplies.</p> <p>Vehicle access to this unit is not possible. Please contact the camp staff in advance regarding parking.</p>	<p>Accessibility to this unit for a person using a wheelchair or with limited mobility would require assistance. Entrance into the unit is by steep rugged trail. The general terrain is mostly hilly and steep with exposed roots. The unit shelter has a small step up and fire ring is accessible with flat access, but access to the fire ring area may require additional assistance. There is one tent in this unit with ramp access, however the terrain approaching tent is rugged with exposed roots. Entry into the bathroom is relatively flat. There is one accessible toilet stall with raised stool and grab bars. The shower stalls have grab bars and flexible shower head with hose with a raised lip entry that does not permit roll-in.</p>
<p>Pebblebrook – Platform Tent Overnight: Maximum 25 people Overnight Fee (1 or 2 nights) \$125 Firewood is provided.</p>	<p>Five platform tents, five cots and mattresses in each. Open-sided unit shelter with shower and bathroom facilities, picnic tables, charcoal grill, unit equipment, electricity, water and fire ring. Camp will provide toilet paper, paper towels and hand soap. You must provide your own, heavy-duty garbage bags and cleaning supplies.</p> <p>Vehicle access to this unit is limited to the entry point at the top of the hill.</p>	<p>Accessibility to this unit for a person using a wheelchair or w/ limited mobility would require assistance. Entrance into the unit is by steep rugged trail. General terrain is mostly hilly and steep with exposed roots and rock. The unit shelter has wheel in access and fire ring is easily accessible and flat with roll-in entry though the ground surrounding it has loose soil and rocks. There is not a tent in this unit with ramp access. Entry into the bathroom is approx. one step onto the concrete porch. There is 1 accessible toilet stall w/ raised stool and grab bars. The shower stalls have grab bars, flexible shower head with hose and a raised lip entry that does not permit roll-in.</p>

<p>Shady Oaks – Platform Tent Overnight: Maximum 32 people Overnight Fee (1 or 2 nights) \$125 Firewood is provided.</p>	<p>Eight platform tents, four cots and mattresses in each. Open-sided unit shelter with shower and bathroom facilities, picnic tables, charcoal grill, unit equipment, electricity, water and fire ring. Camp will provide toilet paper, paper towels and hand soap. You must provide your own, heavy-duty garbage bags and cleaning supplies.</p> <p>Vehicle access to this unit is limited to the entry point at the bottom of the hill.</p>	<p>Accessibility to this unit for a person using a wheelchair or with limited mobility would require assistance. Entrance into the unit is by steep rugged trail; the general terrain is mostly hilly and steep with exposed roots and rock; the unit shelter has wheel in access and fire ring is easily accessible and flat with roll-in entry, however the ground surrounding it has loose soil and rocks. There is one tent in this unit with ramp access. Entry into the bathroom is approximately one step onto the concrete porch. There is one accessible toilet stall with raised stool and grab bars. The shower stalls have grab bars and flexible shower head with hose with a raised lip entry that does not permit roll-in.</p>
<p>Tree Tops – Hammock Camping Overnight: Maximum 25 people 12 people in Hammock – 4 people in Platform Tent – 9 people bring your own tent Overnight Fee (1 or 2 nights) \$125 Firewood is not provided.</p>	<p>One platform tent with four cots and mattresses. Four platforms with space for 3 hammocks. Bring your own tent 2-3 tents max 9 people. Open-sided unit shelter with picnic tables, charcoal grill, unit equipment, electricity, latrines, water and fire ring. There are no shower facilities available at this unit. Unit shelter, power outlets and latrine are lit by solar power. Limit your use of power supplied items. You must provide your own toilet paper, paper towels, hand soap, heavy-duty garbage bags and cleaning supplies.</p> <p>There is limited parking at this unit. Please contact the camp program coordinator in advance to ensure access.</p>	<p>Accessibility to this unit for a person using a wheelchair or with limited mobility would require assistance. Entrance into the unit is steep, hilly and rugged. The general terrain at the unit is gently sloping and flat in some areas. The unit shelter fire ring has wheel in access. There is no tent in this unit with ramp access. This unit has a latrine that is accessible to a person using a wheelchair, however the terrain approaching the latrine would be difficult to navigate for a person with mobility restriction and there is a slight step into the building. There is an accessible stall with grab bars. There are no shower facilities available at this unit.</p>

Ice, water faucet and refrigeration equipment not available unless arranged in advance.</p> <p>Use of the dining hall does not include use of the kitchen.</p>	<p>This building is largely accessible to a person using a wheelchair or with limited mobility. The general terrain is mostly level and flat for entry purposes. Parking is available close by and access to the front of the building is on paved road and path.</p> <p>Entry into the accessible bathroom is flat and there is one toilet with raised stool and grab bars.</p>
