LEARN AND BE PREPARED TO USE THE LEAVE NO TRACE SEVEN PRINCIPLES TO HELP PROTECT THE ENVIRONMENT ON YOUR TRIP:



## PLAN AHEAD

Get to know the area you'll visit. Repackage and store food in reusable containers.



## CAMP ON DURABLE SURFACES

Walk on existing trails and camp on surfaces that are already impacted or durable enough to withstand repeated trampling.



## DISPOSE OF WASTE PROPERLY

Carry out what you carry in. Never dump anything on a campsite or into a water source.



## LEAVE NATURE AS YOU FIND IT

Don't collect or take anything from the outdoors.



## MINIMIZE CAMPFIRE IMPACTS:

Instead of using firewood and building campfires, pack a lightweight cooking stove and lantern.



## RESPECT WILDLIFE

Observe nature at a distance. Never approach, feed, or follow animals.



## BE CONSIDERATE OF OTHER VISITORS

Keep your voices down and let nature be the loudest sounds you hear.
