


# **Spending Your: Gold Award Hours**



GSUSA recommends a minimum of 80 hours and we've put them into a chart to give you an idea of how you can use those hours.

## Pre-Planning Hours: (up to 15 hours)

- Developing your project.
- Implementing your project.
- Research and planning.

#### Leadership Hours

- Communicating with others.
- Recruiting, training, and supervising your team.

#### Non-Leadership Hours:

- Buying and gathering supplies.
- Setting-up for an event.
- Creating materials to use to market an event or advertise your event.

### Gold Award Paperwork: (up to 5 hours)

- Filling out the Gold Award Project Proposal & Final Report
- Submitting information into GoGold Online

#### Tasks that do not count:

- Time spent completing the pre-requisites.
- From Good to Gold Training
- Time given by the people helping you.
- Volunteering for the agency that benefits from the project.
