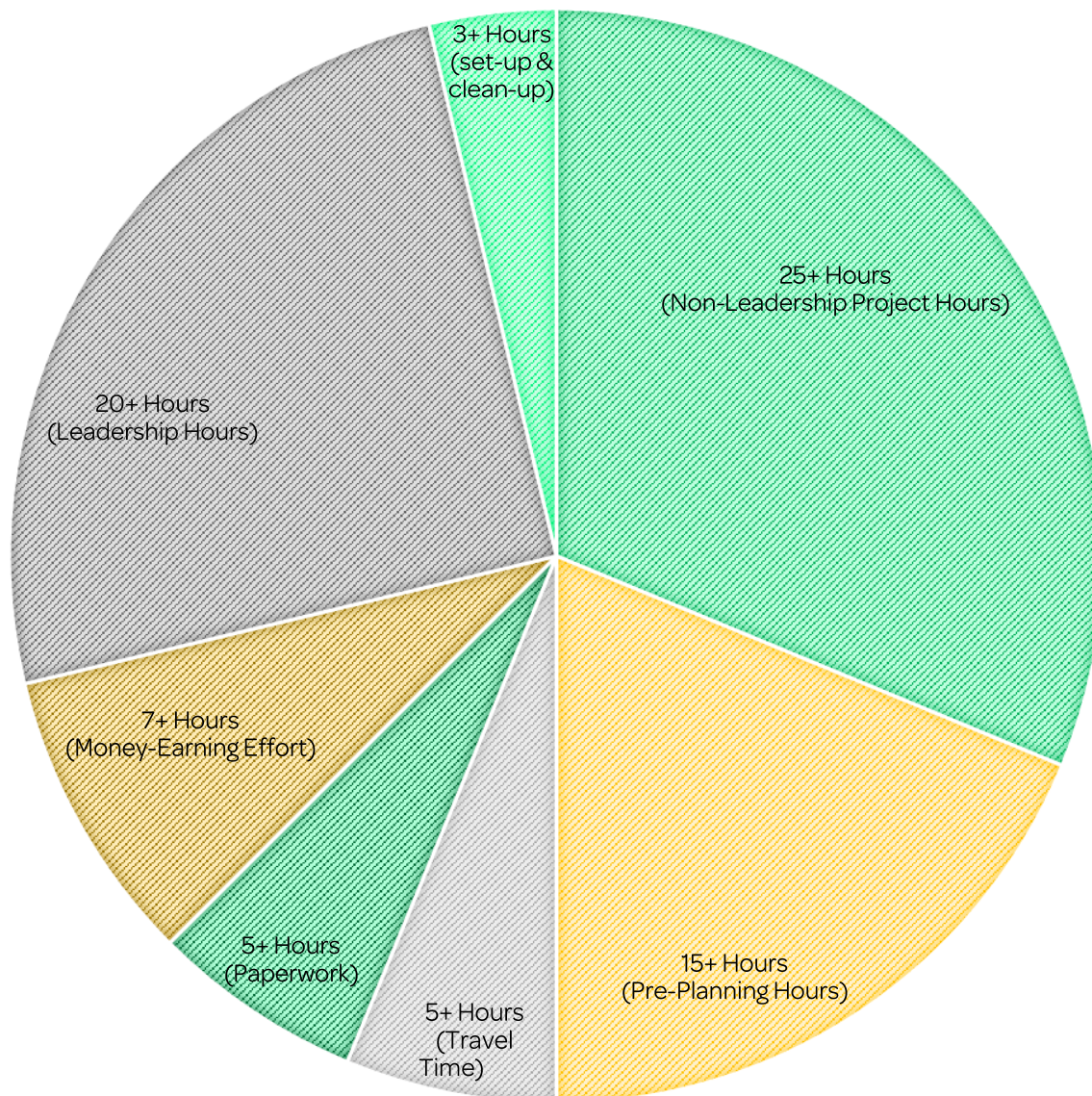


Spending Your: Gold Award Hours



GSUSA recommends a minimum of 80 hours and we've put them into a chart to give you an idea of how you can use those hours.

Pre-Planning Hours: (up to 15 hours)

- ◆ Developing your project.
- ◆ Implementing your project.
- ◆ Research and planning.

Leadership Hours

- ◆ Communicating with others.
- ◆ Recruiting, training, and supervising your team.

Non-Leadership Hours:

- ◆ Buying and gathering supplies.
- ◆ Setting-up for an event.
- ◆ Creating materials to use to market an event or advertise your event.

Gold Award Paperwork: (up to 5 hours)

- ◆ Filling out the Gold Award Project Proposal & Final Report
- ◆ Submitting information into GoGold Online

Tasks that do not count:

- ◆ Time spent completing the pre-requisites.
- ◆ From Good to Gold Training
- ◆ Time given by the people helping you.
- ◆ Volunteering for the agency that benefits from the project.
