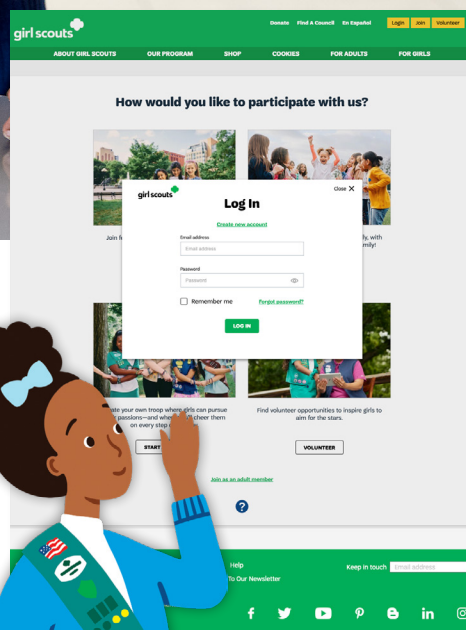

How To Renew

You've accomplished so much this year, and next year holds even more potential. If you're ready to kick off another amazing year of Girl Scouts, caregivers can easily renew members of their household through myGS.



Follow the steps below to renew your household:

1. Sign in to [myGS](#).

You'll find the login icon in the top right corner of any page on our website.

If you have forgotten your password, click **Forgot Password***.

2. Navigate to **My Household.**

From the **My Account** screen, find **My Household** in the left-hand menu.

3. Select **Renew Now** this will place all members in the shopping cart.

4. **Review Your Cart** and make edits or remove members as needed.

5. If you would like to make a donation to the annual fund, select the desired amount and council "333-Greater Atlanta".

6. Check the box to agree to the Girl Scout Promise and Law.

7. Select **Add Payment Details.**

8. Enter payment information and click **Submit Payment.**

9. Save or Print Your Receipt for your records, or check your email for your receipt.



Girl Scouts is a Great Value

Though membership dues are increasing for Membership Year 2027, MY Girl Scouting is still a fraction of other extracurricular activities. In fact, American families spend an average of \$731 per child on extracurricular activities each year, according to a survey done by LendingTree. A year of Girl Scouting usually costs less than \$300 in total per girl, including dues, uniforms, badges, and programming.



However, families don't have to weigh Girl Scouts versus other extracurricular activities. It can be Girl Scouts AND your favorite extracurricular activities. Girl Scouting is a customizable experience that can accommodate your schedule and interests. Plus, a variety of Girl Scout badges have topics related to popular activities like dancing, horseback riding, athletics, and music.

How does Girl Scouts Add Up?
