Frequently Asked Questions



When is check-in and check-out? Check-in and check-out times vary by camp location. At Camp Meriwether, check-in is Sunday from 1–3 p.m., and check-out is Friday from 2–4 p.m. Mini sessions check outs are on Wednesday from 2–4 p.m., and an optional Saturday check-out is available from 9–10 a.m. during weeks 1, 3, and 6—for an additional fee.



Camp Timber Ridge Sleepaway sessions check-in on Sundays from 1–3 p.m., and check-out is Friday from 4–6 p.m. Mini sessions check outs are on Wednesday from 4–6 p.m. For Camp Timber Ridge Day Camp, check-in is daily (Monday–Friday) from 7:45–8:45 a.m., and check-out is from 4:30–5:15 p.m. An aftercare option is available from 4:30–6 p.m. for an additional fee.



How are dietary restrictions met? Our camps can accommodate vegetarian options and certain dietary restrictions. Please list your camper's needs or allergies during registration. Our kitchen staff can provide meals free of common allergens upon request. For other dietary concerns, contact camp@gsgatl.org before registering.



How are camp staff selected and screened? Camp staff are adults aged 18 and older, recruited from colleges, online platforms, and our own Girl Scout community. All staff complete interviews, reference checks, and background screenings. We seek passionate role models who inspire confidence and friendship through outdoor experiences. All cabin counselors are female, though activity staff may include males.



How will I communicate with her at camp? To encourage independence, campers may not bring cell phones. The Camp Director will contact you if your camper experiences unusual homesickness or if there are any health concerns. Parents can follow camp updates on the Campanion App for news and photos. Sleepaway campers love mail—letters and care packages can be dropped off at check-in or mailed in advance.



Can I tour camp? Open Houses are a great opportunity to view camp facilities, tour properties, and explore our exciting activities. Information for each camp open house is listed in the camp guide.

Leadership SESSIONS

Leadership camps give older campers the skills and experience to become future camp counselors. Discover your personal leadership style, practice teamwork, and let your leadership shine.

When registering for the Counselor in Training (CIT) program in CampMinder, your camper will automatically be placed on a waitlist. From there, you and your camper will be contacted to complete a short application for admission and have an interview with a member of our camp team. Our CIT program offers older Girl Scouts a meaningful opportunity to build leadership skills in a camp setting. This two-week, hands-on experience requires commitment, maturity, and a readiness to learn.

How to Register

Registering is easy!

Once you've found the perfect session for your camper, you will click "register." From there, you will create a CampInTouch account, if you do not have one already.

Finally, start your camper application and complete your registration!

Payments Are Simple!

1. Non-refundable deposits are due per camp session at the time of registration. Day camp sessions have a \$50 deposit per session. Sleepaway sessions have a \$100 deposit per session.
2. A one-time, non-refundable registration fee of \$50 per camper will be added to each camper's record. You receive a free t-shirt and patch for each camp location your child attends.
3. If you are not a current Girl Scout, you must register and pay the annual \$55 membership dues (2025-26). You can add this as an additional option when registering for camp.
4. The remaining balance is due May 1 for all camp sessions or your registration is subject to cancellation. Payments can be made monthly with no interest!

Buddies at Camp

Campers are welcome to sign up for camp with a friend, who is within the same Girl Scout level as they are and attending the same camp program. If camp buddies are in different grades such as 4th and 5th grades, the older girl will be placed in the younger camper's age group. Make sure to list your buddy's first and last name when completing your registration. Changes cannot be made at camp check-in. Buddy request changes can be made by updating the application no less than two weeks prior to your camper's session.

The Girl Scout Cookie Program Helps Girls Pay for Camp

To redeem your cookie dough for summer camp, follow the instructions to submit cookie dough payment online via the form as instructed in your reward email. If you would like to use cookie dough as payment for your deposit, email us at camp@gsgatl.org after you have submitted your cookie dough payment through the form online so that we can make your camp registration active.



Changes, Cancellations & Refunds

To make a change to your camper's session, please contact the Operations Team at camp@gsgatl.org. Changes are made based on availability.

Cancellations must be submitted via email to camp@gsgatl.org no later than 30 days before the start date of your camper's session to receive a refund less the deposit and registration fee. Additional options are included in this policy. All deposits and registration fees are non-refundable. The deposit for one-week and two-week overnight sessions is \$100; the deposit for day camp sessions is \$50. The registration fee of \$50 and the Girl Scout Membership fee are non-refundable.

In the event of illness or the death of an immediate family member, a refund less the deposit, registration fee and membership fees is available with a doctor's note or documentation. Documents must be received no later than **September 1, 2026**.
