Alternate Routes, Insider Tips, and Special Notes

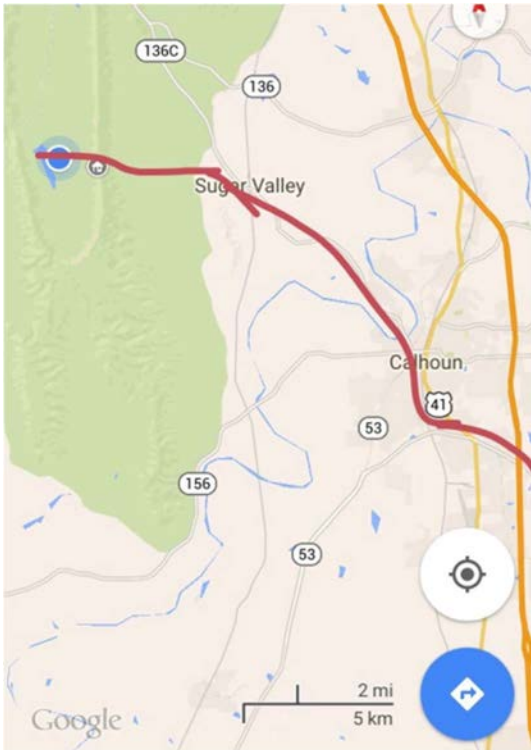


Important Note: There is no cell phone service within ~20 minutes of camp. Please have printed or saved directions with you. That said, if you put in Camp Misty Mountain into your GPS and you do not change your route or reset the directions it will take you directly to our front entrance. GPS location runs on satellites and can track your location no matter what but pulling turn by turn directions requires cell service. If you need anything, please call 706-629-1030 and let us know which town you were coming from (Rome, Dalton/Resaca, or Calhoun).

Fastest Route

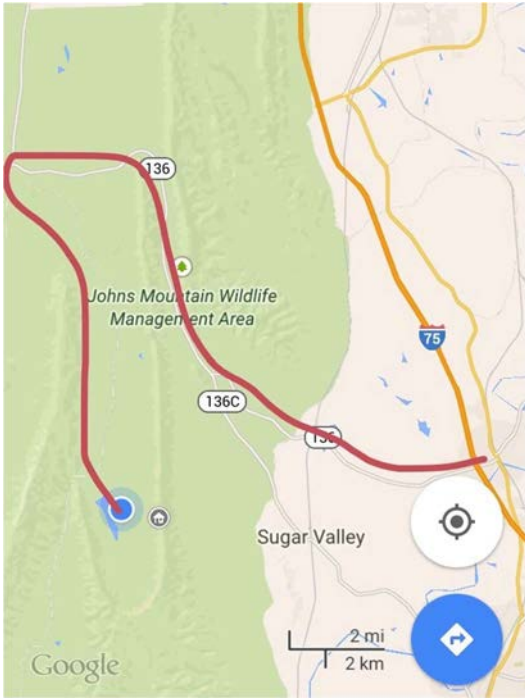
(Recommended): From Calhoun



This will take you right from the interstate up and over the mountain to camp. If you haven't driven this route before it can be intimidating. It's winding, steep, with no shoulder. In the slightest of weather, it can also be very foggy. Everyone at camp takes this route often though and when you take it slow and steady it is by far the fastest route to camp and we trust everyone to make it just fine.

1. Take Exit 312 in Calhoun, GA (the Outlet Mall Exit)
2. Travel WEST (left) on 53 past the Kroger and the Walmart
3. Turn right onto South River Street / 136. You'll pass the school and the National Guard armory on your left. **Stop and get gas there if you need it.**
4. Drive five miles north on this same road. You'll see a convenience store with Hunt Brothers pizza on the corner. Turn left onto Lake Marvin Road.
5. You'll reach a 4 way stop sign. Continue straight. From this point on you will be heading UP our mountain. At the top is the last cell service you'll have.
6. As you head down the mountain switchback, you will see our stone sign and flag pole on the left.
7. Go ahead and turn in there. There's a private residence right at the entrance of the camp and then you will go straight through the metal gate.
8. If you are arriving at the office, it will be the first building past the metal gate on the left. If you are arriving at the dining hall or Daisy Pavilion, please continue straight and bear to the right to the main parking lot. Park there.

To avoid the mountain (North): From Resaca/Dalton

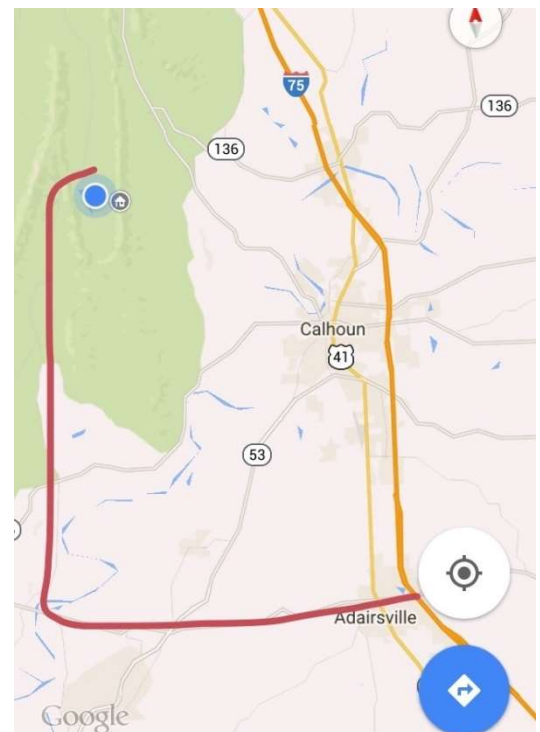


This route will take around the mountain so that you avoid the switchbacks. It will significantly more time.

1. Take Exit 320 in Resaca. (There is a truck stop there for any last snacks, or fuel)
 2. Travel WEST on Resaca LaFayette Road NW / 136
 3. After several miles this road will intersect with 136C... you'll want to keep west on the original 136.
 4. Several miles after this intersection you'll turn LEFT / SOUTH onto Pocket road and travel roughly seven miles.
 5. When you see The Pocket Campground and Day Use site on your left, then the turn to camp is less than a half mile ahead on the left.
 6. Turn LEFT / EAST onto Lake Marvin road. As you drive you'll see pastures on your right, go past several buildings, and eventually see our main gate on your right!
 7. Go ahead and turn in there. There's a private residence right at the entrance of the camp and then you will go straight through the metal gate.
8. If you are arriving at the office, it will be the first building past the metal gate on the left. If you are arriving at the dining hall or Daisy Pavilion, please continue straight and bear to the right to the main parking lot. Park there.

To avoid the mountain (South): From Rome

1. Take Exit 306 in Adairsville
2. Travel WEST on 140 for several miles. Once you cross the "Oostanaula River" your turn will shortly follow.
3. Turn NORTH / RIGHT onto Old Dalton Road NE
4. When this road crosses 156 it will become Everett Springs Road. (This intersection has a gas station and Dollar General Market for any last minute purchases.) Continue driving NORTH. You'll pass Camp Sidney Dew on your right.
5. Turn EAST / RIGHT onto Lake Marvin road. As you drive you'll see pastures on your right and you will pass our boat docks. Eventually the entrance will be on your right, a stone sign and flag pole.
6. Go ahead and turn in there. There's a private residence right at the entrance of the camp and then you will go straight through the metal gate.
7. If you are arriving at the office, it will be the first building past the metal gate on the left. If you are arriving at the dining hall or Daisy Pavilion, please continue straight and bear to the right to the main parking lot. Park there.

Parking Lot to Barn/Boardwalk- 10-15 mins
 Parking Lot to Challenge Tower- 20 mins
 Farmhouse to Boardwalk- 45 mins
 Parking Lot to Canoe/Archery- 8 mins

Tower Loop- 1.25 mi
 Outpost Loop- 2.2 mi
 Walk- Trot- Canter 1.5 mi
 Halls Hike- 1.75 mi
 B Loop- 0.5 mi
