

# 2025 Disney Trip FAQs: for girls and parents

**Q: My family is going to Disney World another time this summer, can I use my daughter's ticket then?**

A: No, this is a group event and tickets can only be used during the travel timeframe set (theme park days June 6 & 7).

**Q: My family would like to travel on our own, can we meet you in Florida?**

A: Yes, please make note in your registration. You will need to make arrangements to receive your tickets prior to the group's travel date. Key cards for your lodging will only be available upon the group's check-in the evening of June 5. If traveling on your own, parking will be at your expense. Please check with the resort for parking pricing.

**Q: Can I use Cookie Dough to pay for my trip Add-Ons?**

A: Yes. Cookie Dough can be applied to **girl add-ons only**; T-shirt and girl park ticket (when not earned). Cookie Dough codes (earned during the 2024 & 2025) can be entered on the registration form as payment for these items and applied to your final balance. **Cookie Dough cannot be applied to guests even if the guest is a registered Girl Scout.**

**Q: If my Girl Scout sells 1700 boxes but does not make it to the 2025 box level to earn a park ticket, can her ticket be purchased through Girl Scouts?**

A: Yes. Tickets will be available for purchase for these girls – they can even use Cookie Dough to purchase their park ticket.

**Q: Can I choose the level 1700 Disney reward and not the 2025 Disney reward?**

A: Yes, but note this will not include admission to any of the parks or the educational experience. There are many things you can do at the resort and in the city without a park ticket. These activities and experiences will be at your discretion and at your own cost. An option to purchase your girl and chaperone ticket through GSGATL will be available when completing your registration.

**Q: Can I choose the 2025 Disney reward and not the 1700 Disney reward?**

A: Yes, but transportation and lodging will not be included – as this accommodation is earned at the 1700 box level. Transportation and lodging will be available as an upgrade as space is available.

**Q: Will we be staying onsite at a Disney property?**

A: Yes. Your stay will be at the All-Star Movie Resort if you are lodging with GSGATL.

**Q: Can I pay for the other 1/2 of my room and not share it with another family?**

A: Yes. When you register, you can purchase the upgrade for a private room. If a girl is traveling with a male (adult chaperone), the upgraded room **MUST** be purchased as our policies will not allow the sharing of a room in this instance with male non-family members. Also note that if a girl is traveling with 2 additional guests (for total attendees of 3 or more) a private room **MUST** also be purchased. Maximum room capacity is 4 occupants.

**Q: Will there be time to go to the park on Sunday?**

A: **No.** All girls/chaperones traveling with GSGATL will be departing from the resort early morning.

**Q: What time will we be leaving and returning?**

A: If traveling by charter bus with GSGATL, expect to leave from Atlanta the morning of June 5. GSGATL will depart from the resort the morning of June 8 to arrive in Atlanta early evening.

**Q: Can a bus seat be purchased for a Girl Scout that did not sell enough cookies to get to the 1700 box level?**

A: If a Girl Scout did not reach the Disney trip levels, she is not eligible to attend on her own. However, she can accompany another Girl Scout who did reach the Disney trip levels as a guest. Additional expenses for this guest will be incurred just as any other guest accompanying a Girl Scout regarding transportation, lodging and tickets.

**Q: What is the maximum room occupancy?**

A: The maximum room occupancy at the All-Star Movie resort is 4. If additional people are traveling an additional room booking is required. Note: This resort does not offer suites.

**Q: Where can I find a more detailed travel itinerary?**

A: After completing your registration, you will receive multiple communication notices leading up to the trip, one of which will include a more detailed timeline for traveling, as well as tips and suggestions for your trip.

**Q: Are there any options to purchase meal tickets or vouchers?**

A: There are no meal vouchers offered as part of a girl's earned reward options. Food and beverage costs will be the responsibility of the girl/families traveling.
