Training Requirements:

Each troop must have at least one adult who has completed the following trainings:

- Safety First
- Day Trips and Overnights
- First Aid/CPR

Events are open to troops and Juliettes with a guardian. We will only accept the number of adults that are required according to the Volunteer Essentials ratios. Please refer to the Volunteer Essentials or the online registration page for each individual event to check the ratio.

All adults attending the event (including parents and guardians) must be registered Girl Scouts and have successfully completed a background check. Please refer to our website for more information about specific training requirements for each event and camp policies.

New Payment Schedule! You can now register for events by putting down a deposit of 25% of the event fees! Pay in full closer to the event start date. Payments must be made in full no later than 30 days prior to the event date. Select the Auto Pay option available at checkout to complete the payment by the deadline. Late payments risk cancellation.

Changes & Cancellation Policy There is a 25% cancellation fee for all registrants who cancel 30 days or more in advance of the event date. A refund is not issued if registrants cancel less than 30 days from the start of the event.

Changes to the event roster must be made no later than one week prior to the program via email to camp@gsgatl.org. All changes to adult participants must be made prior to arrival. Only the participants listed on your roster will be permitted on camp.

If the council cancels an activity or an event for any reason, a full refund (or event credit) is issued. Cancellation requests must be sent via email to camp@gsgatl.org. No refunds are issued for registrants who do not attend the program.

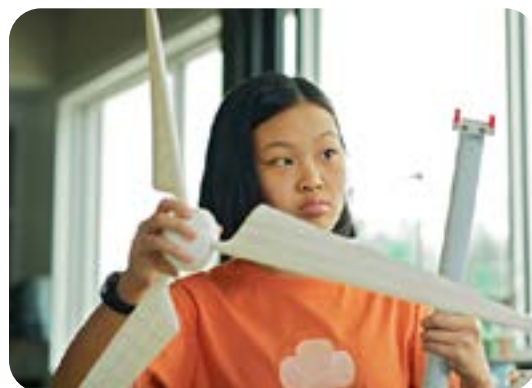
