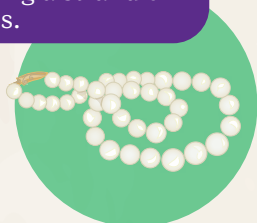

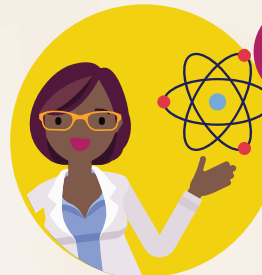
Speaking of treats, did you know the first s'mores recipe came from a Girl Scout camping guide? Find the ooey gooey s'mores.
