

2025 Spring Summit Recap



Almost 100 attendees converged at the Harry S. Downs Center for Continuing Education on the campus of Clayton State University for the 2025 Spring Summit on Saturday, April 12, 2025.



Girl Scout Cadettes, Seniors, and Ambassadors came from across the Greater Atlanta council to make new friends, reconnect with old ones, experience some favorite Girl Scout traditions as well as develop their skills.



We kicked off with a short Welcome to learn more about the history and goals of the Spring Summit as well as to talk about all the opportunities to win prizes and grab some cool swag bags.



From there Girl Scouts experienced two breakout sessions choosing between STEM Career Exploration in Marine Biology, a Situational Awareness/Self Defense Class, a business course to learn how to Pitch Like a Boss, or STEM Career Exploration in Forensic Science.

Afterwards, attendees had the chance to meet and greet during lunch before a fun ALL-IN rock, paper, scissors competition 'with a twist!'



Later Girl Scouts joined workshops focused on our deeprooted history and traditions: The Girl Scout Game Show, a SWAPS Relay Race, and Discovering Camp Magic.



The event concluded with a powerful teen-led panel where five girls (representing the Counselor-in-Training/Junior Camp Counselor program, Lime Green Giraffe, Miss Media, Silver & Gold Awards, and Older Girl Advisory Board) led conversation around leadership opportunities for Cadettes, Seniors, and Ambassadors within the Girl Scout program as well as how being a Girl Scout has personally impacted and changed their lives.
